## ゴールデンウィーク

Golden Week is a long holiday period from the end of April to the beginning of May. There are three consecutive holidays from May third to May fifth, so by connecting these holidays including Saturday and Sunday, a long holiday of about 1 week to 10 days will occur. Some people will go back to their hometown. Others will just stay home because there will be crowds of people. Third is Constitution Day. The Japanese constitution came into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May in 1947. Fourth is Greenery Day. This is a day to appreciate nature such as mountains, seas, rivers, and plants. Fifth is a boy's day (literally children's day). They celebrate the boy's growth during the day. They usually raise "carp streamers," which flutter in the wind.
