

The rainy season is coming to Japan. It is called $\neg \phi$, and usually starts in June for most parts of Japan. The season usually comes in May in Okinawa and the seasonal rain front moves to Northward. Hokkaido, which is the northeast-most prefecture in Japan, doesn't have $\neg \phi$. $\neg \phi$ is 梅雨 in kanji. 梅 means plum and 雨 means rain. The rain season is also plum season, so the season is called 梅雨 (there are various theories). It doesn't rain every day, but we're subject to a lot of raining during this time. If you go to Japan in June, you probably won't be able to do many outside activities.



っゆ is also known as あじさい (hydrangeas) season. There are many あじさい events during this season. あじさい is a popular flower as a gift for mother's day in Japan because あじさい starts blooming the day after mother's day, so they can enjoy seeing it for long term. They have variety of colours and it changes depending on the solid. When the solid is acidic, it becomes blue. When the solid is alkaline, it becomes pink. When the solid is neutral, it becomes red. There are many rainy days in Japan and it makes the solid to acidic, so there are many blue あじさい in Japan.
